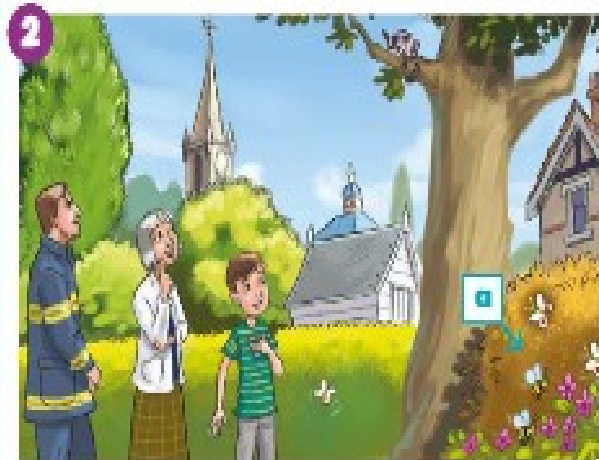

Can I help you?

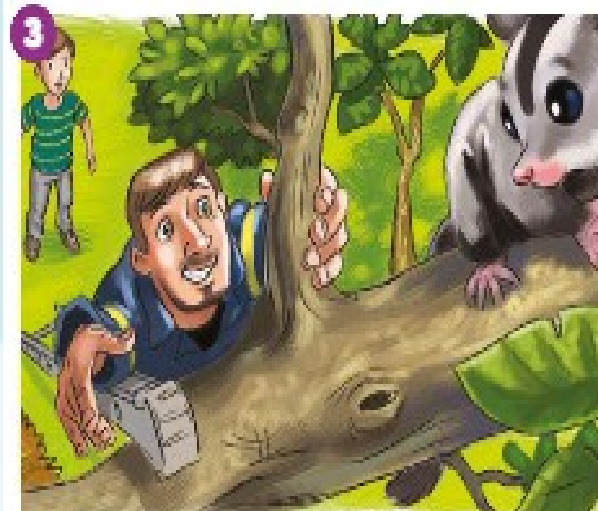
Mrs Hall: Hello! It's Mrs Hall here. Can
