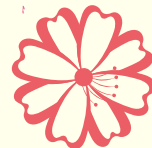

HAIKUS



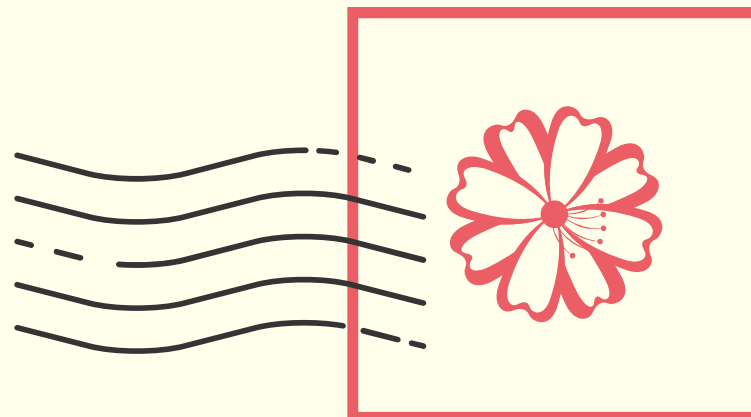
Dear all,

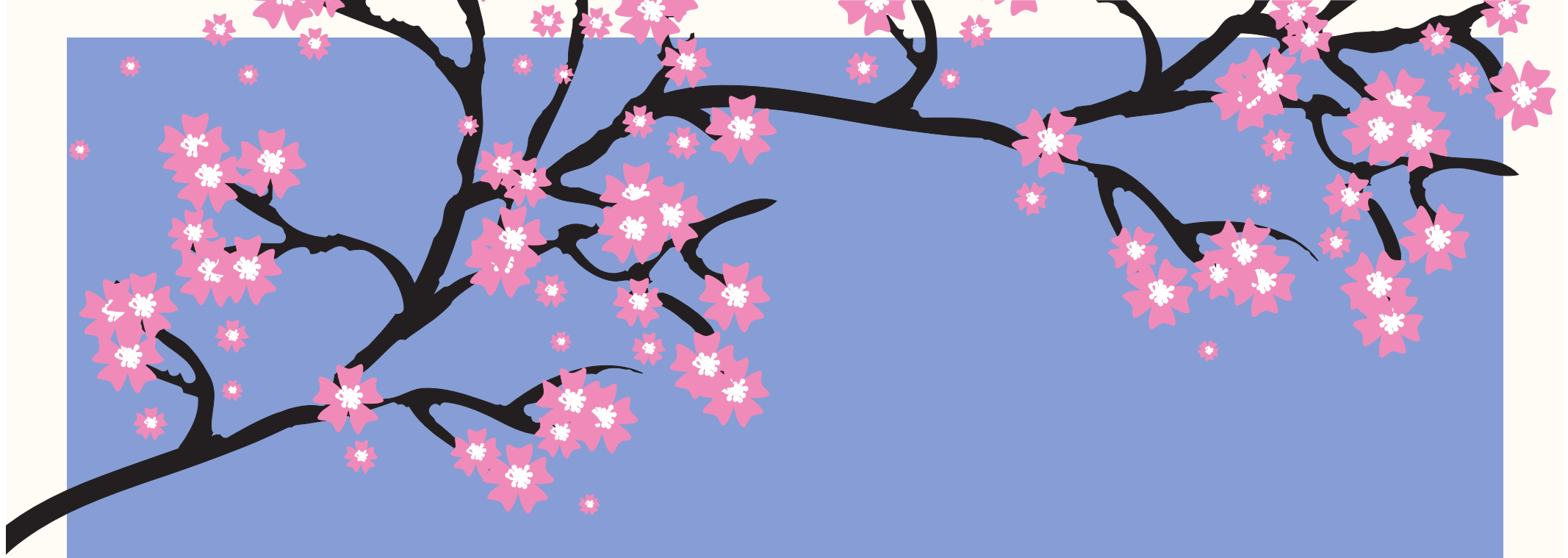

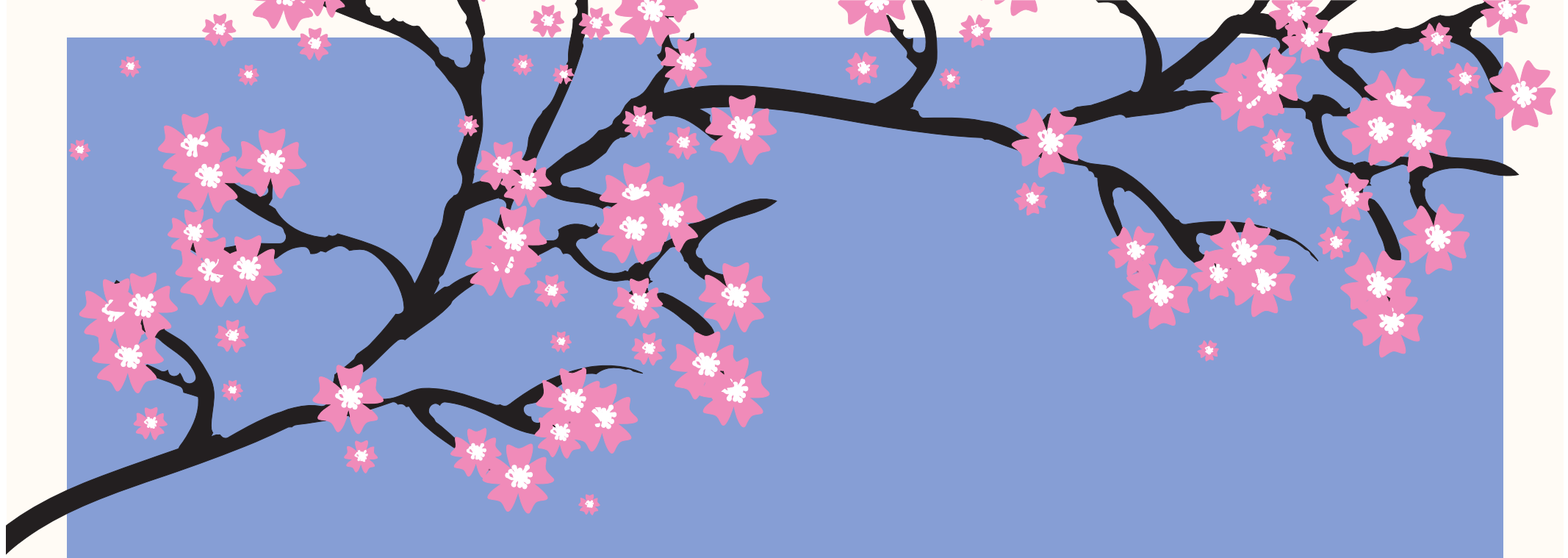
