

## Erasmus+ mobility “Under the same sky”

From April 3rd to April 9th, the reception and mobility of the Erasmus+ project was developed, coordinated by the IES Saulo Torón. On this occasion, mobility focuses on cinema and for this reason it is called “We film under the same sky”.

On April 3rd, during the afternoon, the participants from the partner centers of the project began to arrive. At the airport, a group of participants from Gáldar were waiting for them, who excitedly rehearsed the welcome with their posters. The moment of arrival was special to see arrive and be received by friends from both sides.



On April 4th was the official start at the Town Hall Theater. There the Councilman Don Carlos Ruiz and the Director of the IES Don José Miguel Quesada gave a warm welcome to the participants and accompanying teachers. After this beginning, videos on inclusion made in the different centers and the mobility poster were presented.

After the presentation, the activities related to mobility began.

First, we visited the Finca de Osorio and the old town of Teror, accompanied by a teacher, Doña Nereida Ramírez, who guided us and explained aspects of the places we saw.

On April 5th, it was time to get closer to "heaven" as we headed to Roque Nublo and Artenara. On this outing we were accompanied by two teachers, one of them who guided us, Mr. Pedro Déniz, and the other, Mr. Ángel Hernández, who was in charge of starting to make the short film “Under the Same Sky” with the students, the main product of mobility. This activity is closely related to aboriginal culture and the sky, since in Artenara we visited the Risco Caído museum and the anthropological museum of Casas Cuevas.

On April 6th, the activity went to the capital, specifically to Las Canteras, where the participants enjoyed water activities. Later, Vegueta was visited, where a teacher from the Center, Ms. Martha Cáceres, from the Department of History, explained anecdotes and curious aspects of that old neighborhood of Las Palmas.



On April 7th, it was time to visit the museum jewel of Gáldar, La Cueva Pintada, where the possible relationship with the sky that the traditions of the ancient Canarians had was seen. In addition, half of the day was dedicated to visiting El Valle de Agaete, where visitors acquired skills in typical gastronomic aspects.

That same day, in the afternoon, the award ceremony for the participants took place in the auditorium of the IES Saulo Torón, accompanied by the Director and the Deputy Director of the Center, Ms. Alexandra Santana.

On April 8th, the south of the island was visited, specifically Las Dunas de Maspalomas and Amadores. Places that were also used as a stage for the short film that was made during mobility.

During Friday the 8th and Saturday the 9th the teams from Romania, Italy and Greece were leaving our island. As in all the previous mobilities, they were moments of farewells that put a tear in the eyes of more than one. With this, the mobilities of the project end in which works have been presented in different fields on the sky, such as from the field of literature, myths, art or science. The participants or students of the different centers have worked on different aspects, known European culture and increasingly value internationalization projects.
