SHORT HISTORY



- “Attilio Bertolucci” Secondary School of Science Studies is a new State school opened in September 2007.
- The school building, which is very modern, is located near the city centre.



In 2010-2011 Bertolucci has included classes of music and has become the first Secondary School of Music in the region.



In 2014 it has included a sports academy located in the same building of the science school.



- The school of music has an orchestra and different bands (brass band, wind band...);
- They give concerts at public events and ceremonies;
- They study more subjects (music theory and composition; interpretation; music technologies...).



MISSION

The **aims** of the school are:

- to provide its students with a general **culture**, which will be **fundamental** to face up **university**.
- to fulfill the **potential** and **talents** of each individual **student**;
- to teach the students to relate the experience of the classroom to the reality of the outside world.

A. Bertolucci is a 2.0 School with a **great technological equipment**:

- **Whiteboards (IMB) and computers**

Every class is equipped with a Whiteboard, a computer and a projector; the school also has many notebooks and computers for students and teachers;

- **Electronic register**

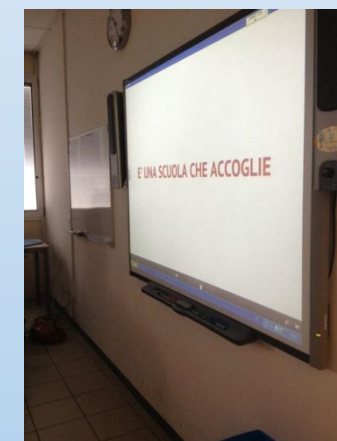
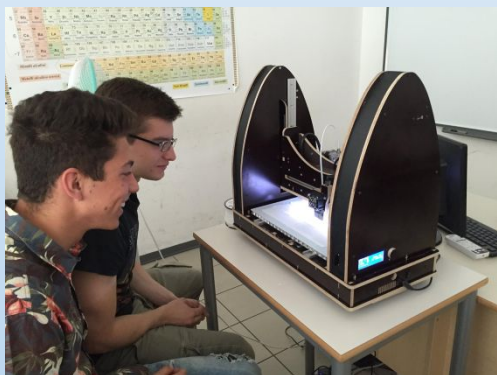
The school is equipped with an electronic register, with automated management of presences: every student has his personal **badge** and the parents have the possibility to access into the site to control the marks, the communications ...;

It is used to experiment in Geometry and Mathematics;

- “**EMPORIO**” – each month our students collect food to help people who are in difficulty;

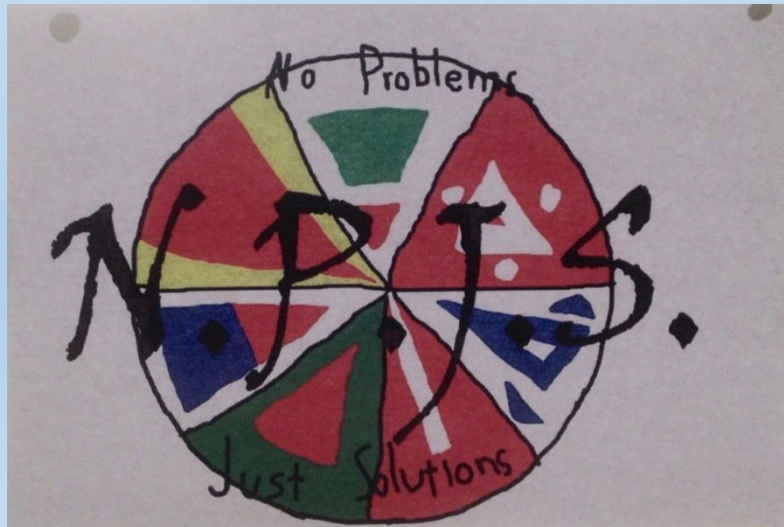


- Volunteering for **refugees, old people, charities,** during the **flood...**

EUROPEAN PROJECTS



- **“PICTURE IN EUROPE” (2010-2012)**

- A Comenius Project which involved schools of six different countries (Italy, Poland, Spain, Turkey, Holland and Germany) and aimed at fighting stereotypes using the language of images.



- **“IN MOZART’S FOOTSTEPS” (2012-2014)**

- A Comenius Project involving nine countries, on Mozart’s footsteps; addressed first of all to students of the music classes.



- **“SEEDS” (ScienceE Education and environmental ethicS) (2012-2014)**

- A Comenius Regio Project between the province of Parma (Italy) and the province of Granada (Spain) to disseminate the best teaching practices in Science and to exchange experiences of job-shadowing.

EUROPEAN PROJECTS



- **“TWIST” (2014-2016)**

- Erasmus Project KA1 – A two years’ project aimed at the formation of teachers on new and innovative teaching methods. It is involving the teachers of Bertolucci and of a partner school in Pitea (Lapland – Sweden).

- **“TODAY WE MAKE TOMORROW THROUGH YESTERDAY” (2014-2016)**

- Erasmus Project KA2 - The project involves one class of “Liceo Attilio Bertolucci” and a school of Friedberg in Germany. It started because we felt the necessity to form our students as European citizens with a common present and future without forgetting the past.

- **“ET EXPLORING TALENT” (2014-2016)**

- Erasmus + KA102 – VET – New training experiences for European teenagers with special needs.

- **“NOT PROBLEMS, JUST SOLUTIONS” (2015-2017)**

- Erasmus + KA2 – Students from six different European countries work on skills and values.
