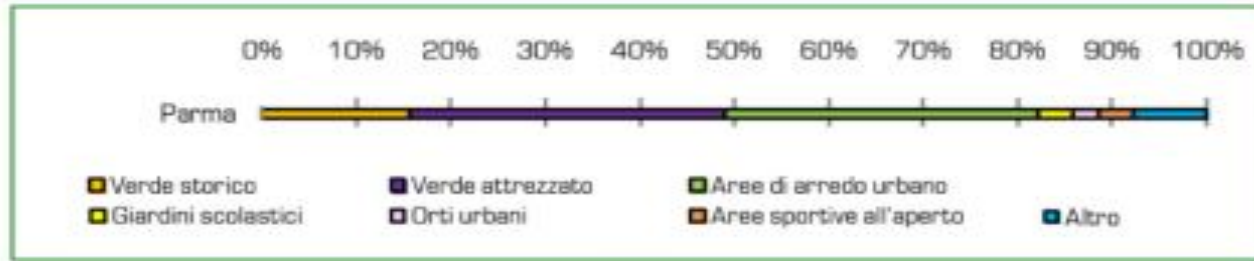




Parks are very important for the livability of a territory. The green areas, in fact, perform both a function of environmental protection and a social function.



The green areas of Parma are for the most part, small parks and neighborhood gardens with games for children, dog areas, or green areas created for aesthetic purposes.

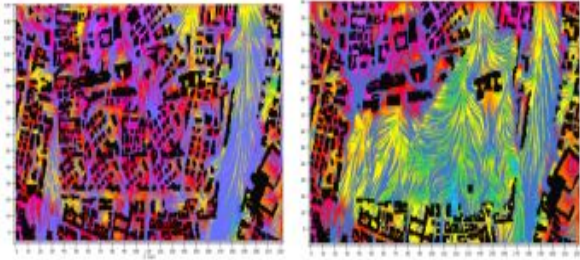
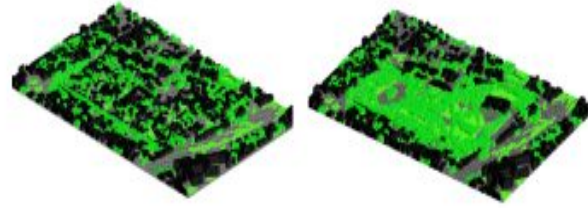

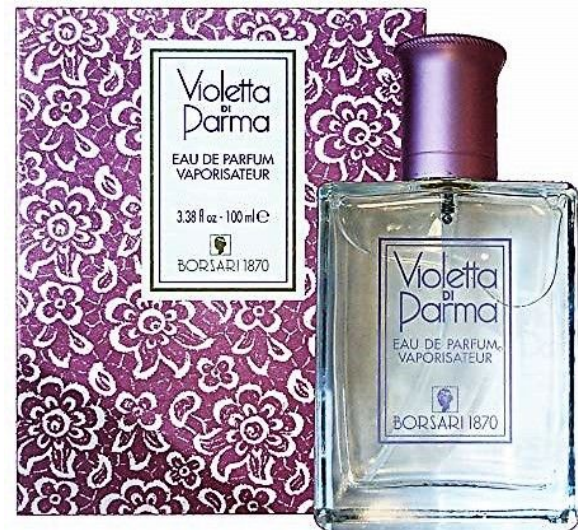

The Ducal Park was built by the Dukes of Parma in the mid 1500s near the torrent that flows in the middle of the city. Several studies have shown how the presence of the Ducal Park has not only an historical value but it represents a really good urban mitigation tool. On the left we see the Ducal Park before the restoration of the trees and on the right the current one. It's evident that the presence of the Park makes them cooler and more ventilated neighboring areas.

Green Kilometer is a large reforestation project aimed to create perennial forests where there are lands, public or private, free and available.
